

Economic Recovery Act - LB1024

With an aligned vision to <u>Good Life Game Changer</u> priorities for infrastructure, workforce and innovation investments, <u>LB1024</u> directs significant ARPA, cash reserve and general funds to pandemic and economic recovery initiatives, much of it dedicated to North and South Omaha.

<u>LB1024</u> also specifies that the federal funds from the Coronavirus Capital Projects fund shall be divided and distributed between Nebraska's three congressional districts and directs they be used multipurpose community facilities or broadband infrastructure project grants.
